

**BRUNSWICK QUILTERS**  
**EARLY BIRD BLOCK PROJECT**

**2010**

This will be a block-of-the-month project with some significant differences:

Block will be available in different sizes. You choose which you would like to do.

Block will be a bit more complex than block designs presented previously.

Blocks will be yours to keep. Therefore, if you don't like it, you could throw it away. If you really like it, you could make more. If you really, really like it, you could include it in a quilt or some other item in the future.

If you are really serious and organized, you could plan to make all the blocks from the same general colors of fabrics with the intention that they will all end up in a quilt in the future. Or you may use scrap fabrics until you know if you like this block, or you could use scrap fabrics with the thought of making a scrappy looking quilt. **USE YOUR STASH!!**

We will meet at 9:30 for approximately 15 minutes prior to the regular meeting sessions on the second Tuesdays.

The purpose of meeting will be to "show and tell" the previous month's block, ask and answer any questions that occurred while making the block, receive instructions for the next block as well as any explanation to expedite construction.

This is an opportunity to expand your "bag of tricks," work on something different, yet not be obligated to a long-term project or need to invest a sum of money in new fabric. **USE YOUR STASH!!!**

The reference book for the blocks is Once More Around the Block, by Judy Hopkins. You are welcome to take a look at it, but the specific blocks that will be selected will remain a surprise.
