Project Wrap from Danice Paxton

Supplies:

1 yd flannel

1 yd fabric

1 16 inch mailing tube(from the post office)

Cut 1 piece of flannel and fabric 17 inches wide by the length. With right sides together sew on 3 sides. Turn inside out and sew 1/4 inch decorative seam around 3 sides.

Place tube on flannel side at the unfinished side and roll 2 times and glue down the center of the entire tube. Roll again and glue once more the length of the tube.

Sew ribbon ties 4 inches from each end.

Glue one end of the tube closed.

The other end of tube can be left open to carry sewing supplies when needed.

\*If using a longer tube, cut fabric 1 inch longer than length of tube.
