

Basics of Appliqué Student Supply List

Please bring the following:

Sewing Machine with Zig-Zag Capabilities we will also use blanket stitch and blind hem stitch so please locate those on your machine prior to class – please clean and oil before class.

Power cord

The sewing surface you have for that machine larger than the free-arm

Basic accessories that came with the machine including owners manual

Foot Control

Bobbin Case with extra bobbins (2 – 3 empty)

Supply of needles for that machine Size 70, 80 and 90 Universal, Quilting or Embroidery style.

1ea. Topstitch needle Size 100

Appliqué foot to fit your machine preferably an open toe or clear appliqué.

Small sharp scissors

Pair of medium to large scissors to cut paper

Small iron with pad – not needed by every student – guild may provide 1 per 5 students.

All fabrics and stabilizers will be provided for the \$10.00 kit fee.

All threads will be provided for student use during the class. This class is designed to allow the students to experiment with various threads while learning several different appliqué techniques.

Note: if your machine uses 130/705 H Household sewing needles, I will bring a supply of needles that may be purchased for my cost at the event. Please do not spend a lot of time and money shopping for these items. Unfortunately, I do not have a supply of other types of needles for other machines so, please consult your owner's manual for the type of needles your machine requires and get as close to size as possible as we will be using a lot of different threads and size matters!
