Desk Tool Caddy

Materials:

- 1 5 x 7 plastic desk top frame
- 2 6 x 16 rectangles (front and back background)
- 1 7-1/2 x 9 rectangle (front pocket 1)
- 1 7 x 11 rectangle (front pocket 2)
- 1 6-1/2 x 12 rectangle (back pocket)

Front assembly

- 1. Fold 7-1/2 x 9 fabric (pocket 1) in half, wrong sides together so unit measures $7-1/2 \times 4-1/2$.
- 2. Top stitch along fold.
- 3. Baste 1/4" from bottom edge of fabric.
- 4. Mark the middle of the fabric from top to bottom and 1-3/4" from middle line.
- 5. Fold the 7 x11 inch fabric (Pocket 2) in half wrong sides together. Unit will measure 7 x 5-1/2. Top stitch along folded edge. Draw a line down the center.
- 6. Place pocket 1 on top of pocket 2 matching center lines and stitch down this line. Back stitch to reinforce the stitching at the top.
- 7. Evenly gather the fabric at the bottom and stitch down the other two marked lines. This will make 4 pockets.
- 8. Fold 6 x 16 fabric (front background) in half lengthwise. Unit will measure 6 x 8.
- 9. Place pocket 1 and 2 on background. (Pockets will be facing background) Sew ½ inch on the bottom easing in extra fabric.
- 10. Turn pockets to the back side and iron so seam is on the bottom.
- 11. Match sides and baste or pin.
- 12. Sew pocket 1 and 2 to background at center line.

Back assembly

- 1. Fold 6-1/2 x 12 fabric (back pocket) in half wrong sides together. Unit will measure 6-1/2 x 6. You can adjust this pocket depending on what you want to put in it.
- 2. Top stitch along fold.
- 3. Fold 6 x 16 fabric (back background) wrong sides together. Unit will measure 6 x 8.
- 4. Sew bottom of back pocket to background fabric easing in extra fabric.
- 5. Turn pocket to back side and iron so seam is on the bottom.
- 6. Pin or baste sides.
- 7. Place front and back pockets facing together matching all seams. Folds will be on top.
- 8. Sew 1/4" along sides and top.
- 9. Turn inside out and place on picture frame and fill with your favorite tools.
