

## Notions Bag page 3

Make a quilt sandwich with fabric/batting.  
 Quilt all layer together - as little or abundant quilting - what makes your heart sing.

If your fabric has slipped some during quilting  
 true up to  $14\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{4}$ .

On short sides of quilted sandwich, Fold back  $\frac{1}{2}$ " press.

Pin zipper in place, one side, and stitch, with a zipper foot. Repeat for other side of Z.

With zipper closed, turn bag wrong side out -  
 center zipper. Sew bottom of bag closed. Pull  
 Corner of bag to a point, and mark  $\frac{3}{4}$ " diagonal

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Seam, and stitch across, repeat for remaining corner.

Turn bag right side out.

Binding - fold in half (wst), press. Fold in short  
 ends to width of your bag, press. Place raw  
 edge to top of bag and stitch across.

Turn binding as you would a quilt, use an  
 Applique stitch or machine stitch in ditch  
 or embroidery stitch. Embellish if  
 you like with, beads, buttons, embroider  
 whatever your heart desires! ♡

## Supply List Notions Bag - 7" zipper

Top Binding: Cut 1 4" w x 8½" L

Outside fabric: Cut 1 15" w x 9" L

Lining fabric: Cut 1 15" w x 9" L

Batting: Cut 1 15" w x 9" L

Zipper: 1 7" zipper

\* Cutting directions are a tad oversized - you may square up after quilting to 14½" x 8¼"
