

Veterans' Quilts Guidelines

Purpose: To recognize and honor Brunswick County Military Veterans.

How: Create quilts to be given to Brunswick County Military Veterans either at the November Veterans' Recognition Celebration or whenever appropriate.

Who: Military Veterans who meet the following criteria:

1. Served honorably in the Armed Forces
2. Reside in Brunswick County, NC
3. Have not previously received a Veterans Quilt from the Brunswick Quilters
4. Verified by Brunswick County Veterans' Liaison

Process: Names of prospective quilt recipients may be identified in two ways.

1. Nominated by any member of the Guild.
2. Identified by the Brunswick County Veterans' Liaison

The list will be determined on a first come, first served basis. If there are more Veterans than quilts in a given year, the list will be carried over to the next year.

The wheelchair quilts should be between 36 and 42 inches square. Other quilts should be a minimum of 50 X 60 inches and a maximum of 70 X 80 inches. Red, white and blue quilts are encouraged, but not required. Each quilt will have a Brunswick Quilters label sewn in before the presentation.

November Recognition Ceremony

The recipients, along with their families and friends will be invited to attend a ceremony in their honor to be held in November.

Each recipient will receive his/her quilt individually. Light refreshments will be provided and Guild members are encouraged to mingle with the honorees and their families.
