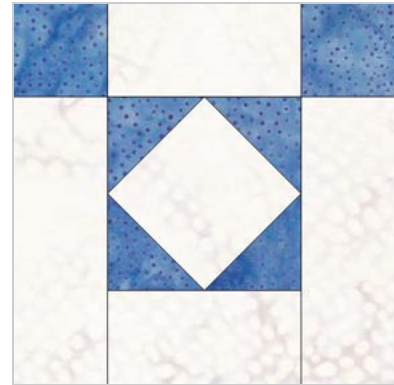


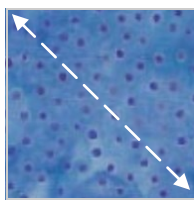
Surrounded Square in a Square Block

Assemble:

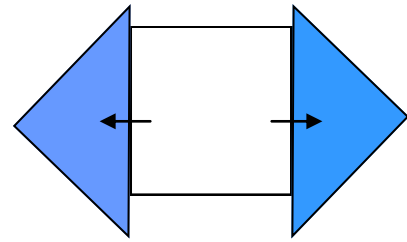
- (16) 2" x 5" **background** rectangles. You will have 8 left over for the next clue.
- (16) 2" x 3-1/2" **background** rectangles. You will have 8 left over for the next clue.
- (4) 2-5/8" **background** squares (from the 9-1/2" wide strip)
- (8) 2" **blue** squares
- (8) 2-1/2" **blue** squares (from the remainder of the 7-1/2" strip)



Make 4



Cut the (8) 2-1/2" blue squares on the diagonal to make (16) triangles. Sew a triangle to both sides of a 2-5/8" background square and press to the triangle.



Sew a triangle to the remaining two sides of the background square and press to the triangle. Square this block up to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2".

Sew a 2" x 3-1/2" background rectangle to the top and bottom of all four units.



Sew a 2" blue square to one end of all the 5" x 2" background rectangles. Press to the light. Sew these two-part units to both sides of the unit you just created to make four blocks that look like the one at the top of the page. Press and square up to 6-1/2" if necessary.
