

If you want to learn the technique for creating New York Beauty blocks using Linda's method but do not want to do the specific class project, you can still take the class – each kit has extra foundation paper!

Class kit is still a required purchase. Depending on the specific class project, you will receive the handout and enough foundation paper (plus a couple extra) for the project that the class is doing.

Once you learn the technique, you can do any of the quilts in any of Linda's books or that she shows during her presentation, you may need an extra package of foundation paper depending on your project.

Please bring the following pre-cut fabrics (Note: these requirements are for ONE block). Most students will get 4-6 blocks done in a class depending on how quickly they get the technique, how much they "socialize" (LOL), etc.

- (1) 8" square (top of block)
- (5) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles (spires)
- (6) 3" x 4" rectangles (background spires)
- (1) 4-1/2" square (pie shape)
