

Fabric Requirements:

4 yards Background
3/4 yard Navy Leaf Blender (includes binding)
1/4 yard Leaves on Navy
1/4 yard Leaves on Cream
1/4 yard Navy Pomegranate Blender
1/4 yard Scallops on Cream
1/4 yard Pomegranate on Navy
1/4 yard Scallops on Navy
1/4 yard Red Leaf Blender
1/4 yard Red Pomegranate Blender
2-3/4 yards Outer Border

Things you will find helpful: (not required)

A 4-1/2" fussy cut ruler
A 6-1/2", and a 12-1/2" square-up ruler
A No Math Ruler
A walking foot or sharp pins

Before starting this or any other project, wash and press your fabric. If you like the behavior of crisp fabric as you cut, sew and press your project, use spray sizing when you press it. Take the time to clean your machine, put in a new needle and fill a few bobbins. Unless the pattern tells you otherwise, you should assume that the seam in any quilt pattern is $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Read over this pattern before you start to sew. Make sure you understand all the directions before you begin cutting. For example, this pattern uses the No Math method of making Flying Geese. If you prefer another method, be sure to alter the cutting directions below so you are cutting for your preferred method. All strips are cut by Width of Fabric (WOF.) Pressing means just holding the iron over a spot for a moment or two. Don't drag the iron back and forth as you normally do when ironing. That might distort your seams.

4 yards Background

Cut (20) strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the WOF. From those strips, cut (24) $1\frac{1}{2} \times 12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and (24) $1\frac{1}{2} \times 14\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Cut (11) strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the WOF. From those strips, cut (24) $2\frac{1}{2}$ squares and (48) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ " Background rectangles. You will have (1) strip left over for the Four-Patch blocks.

Cut (17) strips $2\frac{7}{8}$ " wide by the WOF. From those strips, cut (96) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares for the Flying Geese

Cut (6) strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the WOF. From those strips, cut (48) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Cut (4) strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the WOF. From those strips, cut (24) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for the QSTs

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard Navy Leaf Blender

Cut (1) strip $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the WOF. From this strip, cut (6) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for the QSTs.

Cut (8) strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the WOF for the binding.

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Leaves on Navy

Cut (3) strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the WOF. From those strips, cut (24) $2\frac{1}{2}$ squares. You will have (1) strip left over for the Four-Patch blocks.

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Leaves on Cream

Cut (1) strip $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the WOF. From this strip, cut (6) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for the QSTs.

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Navy Pomegranate Blender

Cut (1) strip $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the WOF. From this strip, cut (6) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for the QSTs.

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Scallops on Cream

Cut (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strip wide by the WOF. From this strip, cut (6) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for the QSTs.

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Pomegranate on Navy

Cut (1) strip $5\frac{1}{4}$ " wide by the WOF. From this strip, cut (6) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares for the Flying Geese

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Scallops on Navy

Cut (1) strip $5\frac{1}{4}$ " wide by the WOF. From this strip, cut (6) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares for the Flying Geese

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Red Leaf Blender

Cut (1) strip $5\frac{1}{4}$ " wide by the WOF. From this strip, cut (6) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares for the Flying Geese

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Red Pomegranate Blender

Cut (1) strip $5\frac{1}{4}$ " wide by the WOF. From this strip, cut (6) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares for the Flying Geese

$2\frac{3}{4}$ yards Outer Border
